

- Shows housing, education, employment, demographic, and health data in relation to transit






Audience


- The primary audience for this tool is service providers, researchers without the resources of a professional, and community groups needing to advocate for equity on their own behalf.

 - Denver Urbanism blogger investigating housing density near light rail stations






- Online repository of data-driven infographics that explain the state of our region






