DPH Outreach Testing Services



Outreach Services offers free HIV and STD testing at community sites*

- Syphilis testing
- Triple site testing for Gonorrhea and Chlamydia
- Hepatitis C testing
- PrEP education and referrals
- Point of Care

*Most of these Outreach Testing Venues are organizations which provide services to Men who have Sex with Men (MSM).





What is the issue?



Despite decreasing incidence of HIV in Denver, disparities in HIV rates still exist including HIV diagnoses rates among Black and Hispanic individuals compared to White individuals.

DENVER HIV Diagnoses 2016



Disparity Between Population and HIV Diagnoses

Race/Ethnicity	% of Denver Population*	% of HIV Diagnoses**
White non-Hispanic	54%	44%
Latinx/Hispanic	30%	36%
Black	10%	16%

What did we do?




- Compared demographics of people recently diagnosed and those we tested
- Compared geographic characteristics of people recently diagnosed and those we tested


Outreach Testing vs New HIV Diagnoses




Disparity Between Individuals Newly Diagnosed in Denver (2016) and Outreach Testing Clients (April 2017 - June 2017)

Race/Ethnicity	% New HIV Diagnoses in Denver	% Outreach Testing
White non-Hispanic	44%	61%
Black	16%	6%
Latinx/Hispanic	36%	22%

Outcomes



- Used data to compare demographics of those tested
- Goals
 - > Test more people of color and maintain number of white people tested
- Outreach to Denver Health clinics in underserved neighborhoods
 - > Montbello neighborhood
 - > Southwest Denver neighborhood
- Creation of a testing network with community organizations who offer testing services in settings more likely to serve Black and Hispanic/Latinx individuals
- Marketing campaign that is inclusive of different races and ethnicities
